## 2022-2023 Registration Process



1. Circle or write in courses for ALL eight course request boxes with the course number and course name.
2. Fill in ALL four alternate classes with the course number and course name in ranking order of preference.
3. All $8^{\text {th }}$ grade students take English, U.S. History, Science, Math 8, P.E., Health and Digital Studies. Please review SRI lexile scores on the course request form to help you make course decisions.

4. For some students, we included some fine arts classes (art and music) and reading intervention classes that you are required to take. If you have Enriched Reading in your schedule, please read over the attached Enriched Reading letter. If you have questions, please talk to a counselor.
5. Math: The math progression will be as follows: Math $7 \rightarrow$ Math 8 : Math 7 Honors $\rightarrow$ Math 8 Honors; Accelerated Math 7/8 $\rightarrow$ Secondary Math 1 Honors.
a. Check the box for "interested in Honors Math 8." Students may earn a Math 8 Honors designation on their transcript if they choose to complete the honors opportunities offered throughout each term in their math class
6. P.E.: One semester of P.E. 8 is required for all $8^{\text {th }}$ graders. Students can take P.E. 8, Basketball 8 or Fitness 8 if they want a full year of P.E.
7. Honors Classes: If you are interested in honors classes, you may look at the honors information sheet found on the counseling webpage to help you make your decision.
8. Band: Choose the next band level in which to enroll. You must be enrolled in band to take Jazz Band.
9. Choir: Boys' or Girls' Choir Level 1 can be one semester or a full year. Indicate semester or full year on your course request form. Students may also take Choir 2 Millcreek Chorale (mixed choir) if they have previously taken Choir Level 1 in $7^{\text {th }}$ grade.
10. Career and Technical Education (CTE):
a. Word Processing/Keyboarding: This is your last chance to learn keyboarding skills. If you cannot type at least 30 wpm with $80 \%$ accuracy, you SHOULD take a keyboarding class in $8^{\text {th }}$ grade.
b. Digital Literacy: This is a state required class to take $8^{\text {th }}$ grade. All $8^{\text {th }}$ grade students will be enrolled in this class.
11. Application Classes - If you are interested in being a teacher assistant, office assistant, copy room assistant, counseling assistant, library assistant, peer tutor or take the yearbook class, please complete the online application found on the counseling webpage. List these classes as alternate choices on your course request form. $9^{\text {th }}$ graders get first choice with these positions.
