5. Honors Classes: You must decide if your child would be an appropriate fit for an honors class.

To sign up for an honors class:

- a. Circle the choice on your course request form.
- b. Read over and complete the honors application and turn it in with your course request form.
- c. **Math:** On the green course request form, we have enrolled all students in Math 7. Students will be placed in Accelerated Math regarding their CoGat score. Students may earn a Math 7 Honors designation on their transcript if they choose to complete the honors opportunities offered throughout each term.

6. Fine Arts

Students are required to take at least one semester of a Fine Arts class in 7^{th} grade. This can be band, orchestra, music exploration, or art.

- a. **Music:** This can be band (full year), orchestra (full year), or the music exploration class (one semester). If you choose band or orchestra, write in the instrument you are choosing to play. If you choose band, complete the summer band form that is included in your packet.
- b. Visual Arts: There are three art classes available to 7th grade students: Art Foundations (introduction to art),
 2-D Art, and 3-D Design. These are all semester courses. Art Foundations is the first art class to take and is the prerequisite to all other art classes.

7. Other Requirements

- a. **Keyboarding Applications:** Keyboarding is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** for all students unless they type 30 wpm or faster and they have a minimum of 80% accuracy. We will place all students in a keyboarding class unless they have demonstrated the minimum proficiency. If you think your child could test out of Keyboarding, follow the instructions in the 7th grade newsletter. Please turn in the certificate with your registration form.
