MILLCREEK JUNIOR HIGH FEE PAYMENT AND FINAL REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Final registration and fee payment options are now available online. Please follow the instructions below to complete the registration process. Final registration must be completed by **Friday, August 9**. You will need to have a my.DSD guardian account. If you do not have a my.DSD guardian account, click here: (<u>Guardian Account Setup</u>) for instructions to set one up. For Spanish, change the language in upper right-hand corner.

There are **5** steps to complete the registration process:

- 1. Electronically sign all forms in my.DSD
- Pay registration fees in my.DSD
 If a special consideration of a locker assignment is needed, please fill out this <u>form</u>
- 3. Locker assignments can be seen on student schedules.
- 4. Access schedule and assigned locker in my.DSD after Wednesday, August 7 after 5:00 pm.
- 5. Read the "Additional Information" below.

Step 1 - Electronically Sign ALL Forms in (my_DSD

Parents and students must log on to my.DSD to read and electronically sign all required documents. When logging into the account the following message will appear:

Step 2 - Pay Registration Fees

While logged onto the my.DSD quardian account, pay registration fees by following the steps below:

- → "Payments"
 - → "Pay for Fees/Lunch"
 - → "Fees/Fines Owed" This will list the required registration fees for your student. **These**fees must be paid before schedule can be viewed. Please click to add the
 fee to the shopping cart. You will be invoiced for individual class fees the second
 week of school.
 - → "Optional Fees" Please add any additional items to your shopping cart.
 - A parent donation is available and is suggested in lieu of a school-sponsored fundraiser.
 - The P.E. uniform is NOT required. For your convenience, you may pay for the P.E. clothing and then pick it up in your P.E. class.
 - If students are interested in a yearbook, it must be purchased by December 1st or there will be an additional \$5 late fee.
 - Please consider signing up as a member of the PTA (\$5).

Check out - When all fees have been loaded to the shopping cart click on "Checkout" to make payment.

On Wednesday, August 7, after 5:00 pm, you can view your student's schedule on my.DSD, if all registration fees have been paid.

Fee Waiver - An application must be submitted, along with supporting documents, to the office no later than <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>August 7th</u>. Fee Waiver forms are available online (<u>English Spanish</u>) or in the main office. Students applying for a fee waiver will not be able to see their schedule online until their application has been processed. Please see the following <u>link</u> for more information.

Step 3 - View Schedule and Locker Assignment

When all of the above steps have been completed, schedules and locker assignments will be available through my.DSD on **Wednesday**, **August 7**, **after 5:00 pm**.

- To see student schedules, click on "Academics" and then "Schedule" in my.DSD. To see the assigned locker, click on "Academics" and then "Reports".
- As a reminder, with the implementation of a block schedule, periods 1 4 will be A-day classes while periods 5 - 8 will be B-day classes. RAP (10th period) is held Monday-Thursday at the end of the day.
- On Monday, August 12, from 8:00 am 1:00 pm students are invited to come to the school to try their lockers and find their classrooms. Staff will be available to answer any questions.
- Fees must be paid in order to view schedules.

Schedule & Counselor Information – Please be aware that great efforts were made to give students all of the classes they requested. In some circumstances, students were given alternate classes as a result of conflicts due to when classes were taught or limited space. Please note the following:

Schedule changes, for reasons other than not having eight scheduled classes or having a duplicate class, will result in a \$10.00 fee that can be paid with cash, check, or online. If students need to change their schedule, please follow either of the options below:

- 1. Schedule Change Form Complete a <u>Schedule Change Request Form</u> and turn it into the Counseling Center with your \$10.00 payment attached. Counselors will begin to look at schedule changes beginning Thursday August 8th. OR
- 2. Schedule an appointment Beginning July 30th appointments may be scheduled with a counselor through my.DSD. Appointments will be available on Thursday, August 8, Friday, August 9, Monday, August 12, Tuesday, August 13, Wednesday, August 14, and Monday, August 19. There is still a \$10.00 charge. These appointments are **optional**. You will receive a notification through your my.DSD account that you have an appointment to schedule, but you **ONLY** need to schedule an appointment if you need a class change. To schedule an appointment through the my.DSD guardian account, follow the path below:
