## Millcreek Junior High School $9^{\text {th }}$ Grade <br> 2023-2024 Registration Process <br> 

1. Circle or write in courses for ALL eight course request boxes with the course number and course name.
2. Fill out ALL four alternate classes with the course number and course name in ranking order of preference.
3. All students take English, Geography, Science, and Secondary Math 1. Please review SRI lexile scores on the course request form to help you make course decisions.

4. Math - The math progression will be as follows: Math $8 \rightarrow$ Sec. Math 1 ; Math 8 Honors $\rightarrow$ Sec. Math 1 Honors; Secondary Math 1 Honors $\rightarrow$ Secondary Math 2 Honors (Students who take Sec. Math 1 Honors will receive differentiated instruction and be required to complete an additional unit each term.)
5. P. E. - Students need 1.5 P.E. credits for high school graduation. We strongly encourage $\underline{\text { ALL }} 9^{\text {th }}$ grade students to enroll in Fit for Life, Basketball 9, or Fitness 9 to earn P.E. credit in $9^{\text {th }}$ grade.
6. Digital Studies Credit - Students need to take one computer class ( 0.5 credits) from grades $9-12$. Exploring Computer Science will give students their Digital Studies credit in $9^{\text {th }}$ grade for graduation requirements.
7. Honors Classes - If you are interested in honors classes, you may look at the honors information sheet found on the counseling webpage to help you make your decision.
8. Band - Choose the next band level to enroll. You must be enrolled in band to be in Jazz Band.
9. Choir - If you are interested in Millcreek Chorale (mixed choir) or Madrigals (auditioned mixed choir) you must be currently enrolled in Choir 1 or audition with Ms. Davis.
10. Seminary - This class is called Released Time. This is a full year class. You will NOT receive credit toward graduation for this class, but you will still graduate on time with 27 credits.
11.
