**2019 – 2020 Registration Process**

1. Circle or write in courses for **ALL eight** course request boxes with the course number and course name.
2. Fill out **ALL four alternate classes** with the course number and course name in ranking order of preference.
3. All students take English, Geography, Science, and Secondary Math 1. Please review End of Level test and SRI lexile scores on the course request form to help you make course decisions. A student is considered **proficient** in a subject area if they earned a 3 or 4 on their end of Level test. Earning a 1 or 2 is **non-proficient**. Complete End of Level results can be accessed through my.DSD>reports>testing results.

The SRI Lexile proficiency is as follows:

4. **Math** – The math progression will be as follows: Math 8-> Sec. Math I; Math 8 Honors->Sec. Math I Honors; Secondary Math I Hon. ->Secondary Math II Honors. We will determine final math placement by proficiency levels with End of Level math equivalent scores and teacher recommendation. We will contact you in May if we have concerns about the math placement.
5. **P. E.** – Students need 1.5 P.E. credits for high school graduation. We strongly encourage **ALL** 9<sup>th</sup> grade students to enroll in P.E. Skills & Techniques 9 or P.E. Team Sports to earn P.E. credit in 9<sup>th</sup> grade.
6. **Honors Classes** - If you are interested in honors classes, you must complete an honors application and turn it in with your course request form.
7. **Band** – Choose the next band level to enroll. You must be enrolled in band to be in Jazz Band.
8. **Choir** - If you are interested in the year-long Mustang Choir, you must be currently enrolled in choir or audition with Mrs. Baer. If you are interested in the semester or full year choir (Mixed Choir Level 1 #1625) you can simply sign up for this class.
9. **Seminary** - This class is called Released Time. This is a full year class. You will NOT receive credit toward graduation for this class, but you will still graduate on time with 27 credits.
10. If you want to be a **teacher assistant, office assistant, copy room assistant, library aide, peer tutor or take the yearbook class**, please complete the correct application and turn it in with your class choice form. List these classes as alternate choices on your course choice form.
