

INATH

- Every Math 7 student will register for Math 8.
- In Math 8 students will learn through differentiated instruction and blended learning with online programs such as Mathia and Aleks.
- Honors opportunities with be given to all students in this course and students will receive the Honors designation on their transcript if they choose to complete the honors opportunities offered throughout each term.
 - Check the box on your registration form if you want to do Math 8 Honors.
- Accelerated Math students will register for Secondary Math I Honors.

HONORS ENGLISH, HISTORY, AND SCIENCE

- These classes are advanced classes. The reading and writing is more rigorous, and the projects are bigger.
- Your reading Lexile level in this class should be 1150.
- Students may sign up for Honors English, Science, or U.S. History.
- If you are interested in taking an honors class, read through the honors form to help you make your decision.

To sign up for an honors class:

- 1. Think about what you love. Take a class in that area.
- 2. Circle the class you want on your registration form.

BAND (FINE ARTS)

- If you are in Band Level 1 this year, sign up for Band 2 Concert.
- If you are NOT in band, you can take Band Level 1 next year.
- Try outs for Jazz band are in May. If you make Jazz band, we put it into your schedule for a 0 period before school.
 - You <u>do not</u> write Jazz band on your registration form.



ORCHESTRA (FINE ARTS)

- If you are currently in Orchestra 1, Mrs. Krivanec wants you to take Orchestra 2. You need to have a full year commitment to this class.
- Orchestra 1 is available to all students wishing to participate in orchestra, who do not have previous experience.



DIGITAL LITERACY

 This is a state required class.
 ALL 8th grade students will be enrolled in the class.

 You learn computer skills for Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, and Excel.
